Dear Mr. Swain:

By authority of the Supreme Court of Ohio granted to the Columbus Bar Association's Certified Grievance Committee, your grievance has been reviewed *carefully* under the standards set forth in the *Ohio Rules of Professional Conduct*. It is our conclusion, based on all of the information brought to our attention, that there is not substantial credible evidence of a Rule violation to justify the initiation of disciplinary proceedings in this matter. Consequently, we are dismissing the grievance.

Mr. Clark interviewed you on March 27, 2013 at Mansfield Correctional Facility. In your grievance, you allege that during the interview, Mr. Clark gave you a list of the home addresses of Ohio law makers. You also claim that Mr. Clark poses a threat to those law makers that he may suffer from a mental illness or drug addiction.

While we appreciate your concern regarding Attorney Clark, the information provided does not allow us to determine whether Mr. Clark acted in an unprofessional or unethical manner. As a result, we do not find clear and convincing evidence that Mr. Clark poses a threat to Ohio law makers. Consequently, we are dismissing the grievance.

Pursuant to Rule V§4(I)(5) of the Ohio Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar, you may secure a review of our determination by filing a *written* request with the Secretary of the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline *within fourteen (14) days* of your receipt of this letter.
