On Friday afternoon, the undersigned learned that the plaintiff had been transferred to Lucasville. It could be viewed as an effort to move him from the jurisdiction of this Court in view of their concerns about the Temporary Restraining Order. Certainly in communications with defendant Clark before this action was filed, counsel for plaintiff was told that the Penitentiary is where Plaintiff had to remain until his classification was reduced. Plaintiff would ask that the Court continue to exercise jurisdiction over this matter since it was while the matter was pending in this Court

that the actions giving rise to the TRO occurred and the other acts detailed in the Complaint all occurred in the Northern District of Ohio.

It should be noted that when he was transferred he was not allowed to take any property, including his blood pressure medication. He has been without it since he arrived there, as was told to me this morning. Odd in view of his transfer to the medical isolation unit supposedly because of concern about his failure to take his blood pressure medicine.
